

## PRAYER REQUIREMENTS

All children enrolled in St. Kilian's Religious Education Program are required to learn the prayers for their grade level. Please teach your child the following prayers. Each student will be asked to recite the required prayers to his or her catechist. See your child's grade requirements below.

<b>Grade One:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary & Glory to the Father
<b>Grade Two:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory to the Father, & Act of Contrition
<b>Grade Three:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory to the Father, & Act of Contrition
<b>Grade Four:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory to the Father, Act of Contrition & 10 Commandments
<b>Grade Five:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory to the Father, Act of Contrition, Nicene Creed, & name the seven sacraments
<b>Grade Six:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory to the Father, Act of Contrition, & Nicene Creed. Name the seven sacraments and the Corporal & Spiritual Works of Mercy
<b>Grade Seven:</b>	Sign of the Cross, Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, Glory to the Father, Act of Contrition, Nicene Creed & Prayer to the Holy Spirit. Name the seven sacraments, the Corporal & Spiritual Works of Mercy & the Gifts of the Holy Spirit

### Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

### Lord's Prayer

Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name;  
Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread;  
and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us;  
and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

### Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee,  
blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.  
Holy Mary Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

### Glory to the Father

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.  
As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

### Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart.  
In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things.  
I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin.  
Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.

### **Nicene Creed**

We believe in God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is seen and unseen.  
We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father.  
God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, Begotten not made, one in being with the Father.  
Through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven;  
by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man.  
For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered, died, and was buried.  
On the third day he arose again in fulfillment of the Scriptures;  
he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.  
We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son.  
With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets.  
We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.  
We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. Lord, by the light of the Holy Spirit, you have taught the hearts of the faithful. In the same Spirit help us to relish what is right and always rejoice in your consolation. We ask this through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

### **The Ten Commandments**

4. Shelter the homeless.
5. Visit the sick.
6. Visit those in prison.
7. Bury the dead.

"Spiritual Works of Mercy"

8. Instruct the ignorant (or more literally: Help people understand and learn!)
9. Counsel the doubtful.
10. Convert the sinner.
11. Comfort the sorrowful.
12. Forgive injuries.
13. Bear wrongs patiently.
14. Pray for the living and the dead.
